

## SABA, BAMSA AND ENDESA X LAUNCH *PARKELECTRIC* TO FACILITATE CHARGING FOR SUBSCRIBED CLIENTS

- With [\*Parkelectric\*](#), users will be able to rent a parking space and charging facilities on a monthly basis for exclusive use in the Saba and Saba Barcelona Bamsa car park network, including 160 kWh per month to charge their electric vehicles with which they can travel around 1000 km per month <sup>(1)</sup>.
- Endesa X, Saba and Bamsa are taking another step in expanding the use of electric vehicles. Those who do not have access to a private charging point (at home, at the office, etc.), will now have the opportunity to join the electric mobility movement. Today, more than 65% of homes do not have a garage where a charging point can be installed.
- The service will be available throughout the Saba and Bamsa car park network, which already features public-access charging stations thanks to the agreement reached by the companies in 2019. Currently, there are 58 car parks across Spain with 235 electrified parking spaces available for public use.

**Barcelona, December 11, 2020** – Saba, Saba Barcelona Bamsa and Endesa X have taken a step further in the agreement on electric mobility signed at the beginning of 2019; together, they are launching [\*Parkelectric\*](#), the first product on the market to make charging easier for users who cannot install a private charger for their electric vehicle at home.

With [\*Parkelectric\*](#), users will be able to rent a parking space and charging equipment for exclusive use on a monthly basis in the Saba and Bamsa car park network; the rental will also include 160kWh per month to charge their electric car. With this amount of charging, an electric vehicle can travel an average of 1000 km per month <sup>(1)</sup>.

This new product responds to an existing need in the market, since 65% of homes in Spain currently do not have a garage in which a charging point can be installed. [\*Parkelectric\*](#) thus delivers a variety of charging services for subscribed clients, who will have a parking space and a charging point that they can use exclusively and with no obligatory permanence.

The service is now available throughout the Saba and Bamsa car park network, where there are already public access chargers. Updated information available at [www.saba.es](http://www.saba.es) and [www.endesax.com](http://www.endesax.com), or through the Saba app – thanks to the agreement reached by the companies in 2019. As of today, 135 charging facilities (accommodating 235 parking spaces) are available and operational across 58 car parks in 25 cities in Spain (A Coruña, Alicante, Barcelona, Madrid, Marbella and Pamplona, among others). Saba, Bamsa and Endesa X continue to work with the aim of increasing the number of public-use parking spaces with charging points for electric vehicles in car parks.

The technology installed is 7.4 kW; since the car parks are open 24 hours a day, subscribers will be able to charge their vehicles well during the night or their working day, with 100% of their battery ready to go in 4 hours.

In addition to their private charging point, [Park Electric](#) users will also be able to enjoy all the additional advantages of the Endesa X charging application: you can monitor your charging process in real time, view your consumption and kWh used in your monthly package. And of course, you'll be able to access the rest of the public-access charging network that Endesa X is launching in Spain for when you need to charge somewhere else besides your usual parking space. You will be able to see all the charging stations available on the map; you can also find the best route to reach your chosen charging point, reserve it, start and stop your charging or even pay for it with a bank card, all without having to register with the application.
