## Saba launches the controlled parking area of La Seu d'Urgell after being awarded its management for a nine year period

Saba Parkings, the car park division of Saba Infraestructuras group, has launched the controlled parking area of La Seu d'Urgell (Lleida) after being awarded its management last March for a period of nine years. This new car park, with 550 parking spaces in the city center, operating all year round, is the first car park that Saba has in the province of Lleida, although the company already manages car parks in a tourist and commercial area nearby, such as Puigcerdà (Girona) and Andorra.

In this regard, La Seu d'Urgell, with 13,000 inhabitants, is the main junction of the access roads to the Pyrenean regions and major land communication hub that connects with the Principality of Andorra. Saba assumes investments of about 200,000 Euros for the renewal of this infrastructure, mainly for the installation of 23 new parking meters, improved signaling, equipment and management systems.

With the addition of this new car park to the network of Saba Parkings, the company manages around 55,111 parking spaces throughout Catalonia, 73 hubs spread over 30 cities. Present in more than 80 cities in Spain, Italy, Portugal, Chile, France and Andorra, the company has about 133.326 parking spaces in 200 car parks. It also includes projects that represent, in the network, about 205 car parks and more than 136.833 managed parking spaces. Saba Parkings belongs to Saba Infraestructuras group, a leading company in car park management since 1966, and in logistics parks since 1999.
